



## Instructions for Using an In-karta Card

When retrieving your In-karta card, please verify that the card's photograph, given name, surname, date of birth and term of validity (3 years from the issue date) are in order.

The In-karta card is a non-contact chip card the size of a standard bank payment card, in which a Mifare DESFire<sup>®</sup> chip and antenna are integrated. The card's electronic circuits are loaded with voltage which is indicated in the antenna if placed in an electromagnetic field generated by a terminal or card reader (at a maximum distance of 10 cm from the card reader).

In order for the card to function correctly, it is necessary to observe the following rules:

- the card may be used only for the purpose for which it was issued,
- the card may not be exposed to extreme temperatures (below -10 °C or above 40 °C) for an extended period of time, or to electrical or magnetic fields in excess of normal levels,
- it is not permitted to bend, twist or break the card, to modify its dimensions or to otherwise mechanically damage it,
- after retrieving your card, insert it into the case in such a way that the slide opening is on the reverse side of the card,
- it is necessary to keep the card in its case; when communicating with the card reader, it is not necessary to remove the card from the case.
